**VERNON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE JONATHAN ALTENBERG NAMED NEW SUPERVISOR FOLLOWING  
STATE REP. DIDECH'S RESIGNATION**

VERNON TOWNSHIP, Ill. — During a board meeting on Sunday, former Supervisor Daniel Didech resigned his position as Vernon Township Supervisor before being sworn into the Illinois General Assembly on Wednesday. The board voted unanimously to name Trustee Jonathan Altenberg as the new Supervisor.

"I'm proud to be able to serve the people of Vernon Township as their Supervisor," said Vernon Township Supervisor Jonathan Altenberg. "We spent our time as a board lowering levies to help reduce property taxes, and as supervisor I'll continue that mission."

Supervisor Altenberg, an 18-year Vernon Township resident, previously served as a Vernon Township Trustee. Altenberg has been active in the community volunteering for local causes like the BGRA, Buffalo Grove's Youth Commission, and more. Altenberg also works in marketing for a multi-national corporation. Supervisor Altenberg is a graduate of George Washington University and earned his master's at Northwestern University. He lives in Buffalo Grove with his wife, Marah and two daughters.
