1. Assessment appeals are down
 - . 2014 - 1198 appeals
 - . 2013 - 2300 appeals
 - . 2012 - 3700 appeals
 - . 2011 - 5500 appealsOf the 1198, 2014 appeals, 220 withdrew.
2. Values are down in several areas within the township due to vacancies.
3. Mr Braun on Elm Rd is once again protesting his taxes. Mr Braun has protested for years. Assessor Raupp will try to set the record straight.
4. Avon township's assessor's office closed their offices due to lack of funds. Avon Township has many legal problems.

Heidi Mullejans asked Assessor Raupp if he knew what was going to be built on the south/east corner of Riverwoods Road and Milwaukee. That area has been in the planning stages for a long time but is not sure for what purpose.
